Wage Rates effective the first full pay period on or after July 1, 2024:

CLASS A: Includes all Construction Laborers on building and heavy construction work, except Foremen and others failing within specified classifications. Also includes pumps with a three inch (3") or less discharge and not hooked up in battery. Mechanized Buggy Operators and Mortar Mixer when done by hand. Carpenter Tender, Cement Finisher Tender, Mason Tender, Fire Watch, Mechanized Mortar Mixing, Air, Electric and Gas-Driven Tools, Concrete Vibrators, Plasterer Tenders and Plaster Mixers, Crock and/or Pipelayers. Signal Men and Top Men on caisson work. Demolition Laborer.

CLASS B: Air or Electric-Driven Pavement Breakers and Jackhammers over 50 lbs., Tunnel Miners and Tunnel Muckers, Tunnel and Shaft Underpinning contributing to the structural support of buildings.

CLASS C: Drillers and Blasters, Burners and Welders. **(Refractory Industry Work ONLY)** Work inside or outside of digesters, tanks, lime kilns, chests, boilers, and boiler tubes, heat treat ovens, and smoke stacks, including the handling of acid, chlorine, chemicals, epoxies, liquids and cleaning of existing precipitators, hydro blasting, hydro washing and sandblasting.

Foreman: The Employers shall have the right to hire their Laborer Foreman direct, or through the representative of the Union, and said Laborer Foreman shall be paid at a rate of wages to be determined by the Employer, but the said rate shall not be less than one dollar (\$1.00) more per hour than a Class A Laborer on this crew.

General Foreman: rate shall not be less than three dollars (\$3.00) more per hour than a Class A Laborer on this crew.

Apprenticeship: All registered Apprentices will work in accordance with wage and training requirements.
